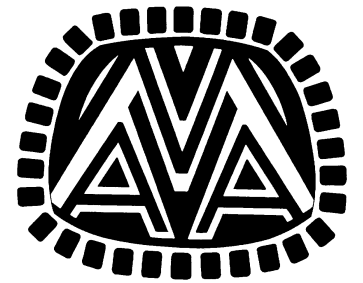

Artist should complete the entry form including sections 1, 2, 3 and 4.

Doing this BEFORE you get to the college on entry day will speed the entry process.

Sections 1 and 2

Please complete as indicated. Please print legibly. SALE PRICE is the price of the artwork.

FEE is \$10.00 for members; \$15 for non-members.

Please do not cut Section 1 and Section 2 apart. That will be done by MAA after judging takes place.

Section 3 - Tags

The tags should be completed and taped to the back of the piece (or bottom for ceramics, sculpture, etc.). Please be sure that the tag (A, B, C) is on the correct piece and matches your entry form.

Section 4 - Your address

Please address the card to yourself ... this is how we let you know if your work is accepted. **Place a stamp where indicated.**

Juror

Ryder Richards, born and raised in Roswell, NM until the age of 16, has lived in the Southwest most of his life. Receiving a Masters Degree in Fine Arts from Texas Christian University he has taught for nine years and been a gallery director for seven years. Currently gallery director and professor for Richland College in Dallas, Richards curates exhibits, writes art reviews, and participates in several collaborative art groups as part of his practice.

In a dubious effort to culture himself Richards has travelled to Europe several times studying classical architecture and the art of various "old masters." While retaining his affinity for these influences Richards has become increasingly interested in the "culture of honor" associated with violence and power found in the Southwest. Burning gunpowder, which references his youth spent hunting, allows many of his drawings to explore socialized forms of violence, often reflecting on the highly romanticized proving grounds of manhood.

Awards

Cash awards totaling at least \$4,000 will be presented at the juror's designation.

Entry Fees

Fees for MAA members are \$10.00 per entry and fees for non-members are \$15.00 per entry.

Entries

- ~Limited to three per artist. Accepted media: ORIGINAL ceramics, sculpture, glass, drawing, graphics, painting, fiber, photography and mixed media.
- ~Two-dimensional work must be properly wired to hang on the wall.
- ~No wet paint.
- ~Midland Arts Association retains the right to screen entries.
- ~Art that is not picked up by Saturday, Nov. 16, will be stored at the owner's expense.
- ~Artist must be 18 years or older.

Entry Date

Artwork must be brought to the Allison Fine Arts Building between 10 a.m. and 2 p.m. Saturday, Oct. 5. Works sent by commercial carrier must arrive no later than Wednesday, Oct. 2. Crating must be re-useable for return. Shipping must be pre-paid to Midland Arts Association, c/o Midland College, AFA 185, 3600 N. Garfield, Midland, Texas, 79705.

Conditions

MAA takes 20 percent commission on all sales from the exhibit. All selected entries must remain for the duration of the show. **No Exceptions.**

Non Liability

Midland Arts Association and/or Midland College, including employees and agents, shall not be liable for loss or damage to any works of art entered. Participation indicates that the entrant understands and accepts this clause and conditions as stated.

- 1) Oil/Acrylics 2) Pastels 3) Photography 4)Graphics/Mixed Media 5)Watercolor
6) 3-Dimensional (Sculpture, Pottery, Jewelry, Stained Glass) 7) Fiber (No Larger than 40in. each side)
