Please do not cut Section 1 and Section 2 apart. That will be done by MAA after judging takes place.

**Section 3 - Tags** 

The tags should be completed and taped to the back of the piece (or bottom for ceramics, sculpture, etc.). Please be sure that the tag (A, B, C) is on the correct piece and matches your entry form.

Section 4 - Your address

Please address the card to yourself ... this is how we let you know if your work is accepted. Place a stamp where indicated.
