**Juror** Born in Anchorage, Alaska, Lindsey Dunnagan eventually moved to Texas where she has spent the majority of her life. In may of 2014, Lindsey completed a Master of Fine Arts in Painting and Drawing from Texas Woman's University. Currently, she serves as an adjuncty professor of Art at Texas Christian University and is working on a second master's in Art History. Shortly after receiving a Bachelor of Enviormental Design Architecture from Texas A&M in 2007, she volunteered for the US Peace Corps and served in Morocco for two years, working with developing artsian small businesses. Lindsey ahs received numerous awards for her artworks, including the distinction of being chosen as 3-time finalist for the Hunting Art Prize, historically the most generous award given to a pinter or drawer in North America. She has also shown in several international juried shows including the *Arts in Harmony 2015 International Show* in Minnesota and the *17th International Open* in Chicago.

#### Awards Entry Fees

Cash awards totaling at least \$4,000 will be presented at the juror's designation. Fees for MAA members are \$30 per entry and fees for non-members are \$45 per entry.
