

## Ft. Davis Plein-air Weekend April 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup>

The Midland Arts Association has organized a plein-air painting excursion for Friday evening and all day Saturday, and on Sunday too if you want. MAA President Rick Reese will host a Planning Meeting with Cocktails on Friday evening, April 7<sup>th</sup> at his cabin near Ft. Davis, (or it might be held at Liz Culp's place - both are near Prude Ranch).

"We'll plan our Saturday of painting on Friday evening," Rick says. "It will probably be in the State Park. We will paint Saturday morning till lunch." In the afternoon, everyone can reconvene at Rick's place to paint Blue Mountain in the late afternoon sun. *Rick will cook supper*, and painters may take part in a friendly critique session.

The event is free, but everyone needs to take care of their own accommodations. Prude Ranch, or Ft. Davis State Park for campers, are recommended. Single rooms at Prude Ranch will be \$85 per night plus tax, and Double rooms will be \$95 plus tax per night - so if sharing a Double room, the cost per person will be \$47.50 plus tax.
