MAA Fall Show

The Opening Reception for this year's Fall Exhibition will be held October 11th from 6:30 to 8:30 pm in the McCormick Gallery at Midland College. The juror for the show is Carol Fairlie, professor of art at Sul Ross. Juror Fairlie's work consists of large scale paintings in oil, depicting interior scenes and sidewalk scenes in varied locations. She has also worked extensively in watercolor and is a member of the National Watercolor Association, and works in jewelry-making, metal-smithing and printmaking as well.

Submission Guidelines

Members and non-members of the Midland Arts Association will find the entry prospectus online at our website: www.maatx.org. A printed copy may also be obtained upon entry of artwork on Saturday, October 6th from 10 AM to 2 PM at the McCormick Gallery in the Allison Fine Arts Building at Midland College. Midland Art Association makes a 20% commission on all sales from the exhibition, and all selected works must remain on display for the duration of the show; no exceptions. Instructions for sending works via commercial carrier can be seen in the prospectus.

Accepted Media

Categories for artwork are listed in the prospectus. Several cash awards will be presented at the Juror's designation. Entry fees for up to three works are \$35 for current MAA members and \$45 for non-members. Entrants wishing to join the Art Association may do so at entry for \$60, which will purchase a 15-month membership through 2019. Two-dimensional works *must* be properly prepared to hang on the wall. The Exhibition runs through November 9th.
