Entry fees for up to three works are \$40 for current MAA members and \$50 for non-members. Make sure your membership is up to date! Digital photograph submissions only are accepted for art selection, with a limit of three works per artist. Accepted Media

Categories for artwork are listed in the prospectus. Several cash awards will be presented at the Juror's designation. Two-dimensional works *must* be properly prepared to hang on the wall. The Exhibition runs from April 20th to June 16th. Midland Art Association makes a 20% commission on all sales from the exhibition, and all selected works must remain on display for the duration of the show; no exceptions. Instructions for sending works via commercial carrier can be seen in the prospectus.
