MAA Members \$40, Non-Members \$50 for up to 3 works of art. Please ensure that your membership is up to date. Payment must be received by the submission deadline, March 4th, midnight. Please send check to Midland Arts Association P.O. Box 4252, Midland, TX 79704.

TERMS OF ENTRY

- Open to residents of Texas, New Mexico, Arizona
- Maximum of 3 artworks per artist
- Original work only, from idea to execution; No reproductions or copies of work published in print or on the internet; No workshop, class works, or work done under supervision
- Not previously exhibited in any MAA show
- Wall work must be wired for hanging; No wet paint; no saw tooth hangers
- Exhibited artwork cannot be picked up early
- Delivery & pick up of artwork are the responsibility of the artist. Shipped works must be accompanied by pre-paid return postage. Do not ship glass. Hand delivered artwork may be under glass. Work must be shipped in high quality reusable carton and include artist name and title of work. No packing peanuts please. Ship directly to the Museum of the Southwest.
- All media accepted and encouraged
- Max size 60"x60" (including frame)

Digital submissions only are accepted for art selection.

- Artwork title
- Medium
- Year
- Dimensions including frame (HxWxD)
- For sale/ Not for sale
- Sale/value price (even if not selling)
- MAA Member (Y/N)
- Student (Y/N), Name of School/University
- Jpg image of entry (uploaded photo should have a resolution of at least 300 ppi, be clear and in good lighting. JPG or PDF files are both acceptable. No more than 4MB in size. For 3D works please submit photos from 3 angles. Please save your image according to the following specifications: Last Name, First Name_Title of the work, Medium, dimensions (Height x Width x Depth)

An artist may submit images of up to 3 actual works. Do not use watermarks or copyright notices.

SALES

Artist contact and price list will be posted on the MAA website <u>http://maatx.org/</u>. All sales will be handled by MAA. MAA keeps a 20% commission on all artwork sold. MAA will issue a check to the artist minus commission. It is the responsibility of the artist to make arrangements to get purchased artwork to the buyer after the exhibition ends. The purchaser may not pick up artwork at the museum.

PICK UP

If the artist is unable to pick up artwork on June 18th or 19th between 10 am and 4 pm, he/she must make alternative arrangement for someone else to pick up their work and provide the name of the alternative person to midlandartsspringshow@gmail.com.
