MAA Members \$45, Non-Members \$55 for up to 3 works of art. Please ensure that your membership is up to date. Payment must be postmarked by the submission deadline, midnight March 2. Please send check to Midland Arts Association P.O. Box 4252, Midland, TX 79704.

TERMS OF ENTRY

- Open to residents of Texas, New Mexico and Arizona.
- Maximum of 3 artworks per artist.
- Original work only, from idea to execution; No reproductions or copies of work published in print or on the internet; No workshop, class works, or work done under supervision.
- Not previously exhibited in any juried MAA show
- Wall work must be wired for hanging; No wet paint; no saw tooth hangers.
- Exhibited artwork cannot be picked up early.
- Delivery & pick up of artwork are the responsibility of the artist. Shipped works must be accompanied by pre-paid return postage. Do not ship glass. Hand delivered artwork may be under glass. Work must be shipped in high quality reusable carton and include artist name and title of work. No packing peanuts please. Ship directly to the Museum of the Southwest: *1705 W Missouri Ave, Midland, TX 79701.*
- All media are accepted and encouraged.
- Max size 60"x60" (including frame).
- Please, no works that must be hung from the ceiling.

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES - Digital submissions only are accepted for art selection via midlandartsspringshow@gmail.com

An artist may submit images of up to 3 actual works. Do not use watermarks or copyright notices.

Email **must include:**

- ❖ Artist name
- ❖ Contact Information (Full Address, Phone number, e-mail)
- ❖ Artwork title
- ❖ Medium
- ❖ Year created
- ❖ Dimensions including frame (HxWxD)
- ❖ For sale/ Not for sale
- ❖ Sale/value price (even if not for sale)
- ❖ MAA Member (Y/N)
- ❖ Student (Y/N), Name of School/University
- ❖ Jpg image of entry (uploaded photo should have a resolution of at least 300 ppi, be clear and in good lighting. JPG or PDF files are both acceptable. No more than 4MB in size. For 3D works please submit photos from 3 angles. Please save your image according to the following specifications: **Last Name, First Name, Title of the work, Medium, dimensions (Height x Width x Depth)**)

Even though art is handled with great care and professionalism, the Midland Arts Association and the Museum of the Southwest shall not be liable for theft, loss, or accidental damage to any works of art accepted. Participation indicates that entrant understands and accepts this clause and conditions as stated. Entries may be photographed for publicity or media coverage and will be identified on the display label. Entries selected for exhibition must remain on display during the entire length of the show.

SALES

Art images and price list will be posted on the MAA website <http://maatx.org/>. All sales will be handled by MAA. MAA keeps a 20% commission on all artwork sold. MAA will issue a check to the artist minus commission.

It is the responsibility of the artist to make arrangements to get purchased artwork to the buyer after the exhibition ends. The purchaser may not pick up artwork at the museum.

PICK UP

If the artist is unable to pick up artwork on May 19 or 20 between 10 am and 4 pm, he/she must make arrangements for someone else to pick up their work and provide the name of the alternate person to midlandartsspringshow@gmail.com.
